❖ **Maximum Temperature Departures (as on 06-08-2026):** **markedly above normal(> 5.1°C)** at isolated places over Assam & Meghalaya, Vidarbha and Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam. **appreciably above normal(3.1°C to 5.0°C)** at most places over Arunachal Pradesh; at few places over Chhattisgarh and Telangana; at isolated places over Odisha, East Madhya Pradesh and Saurashtra & Kutch. **above normal(1.6°C to 3.0°C)** at many places over Coastal Karnataka; at few places over Gujarat Region and Konkan & Goa; at isolated places over Sub Himalayan West Bengal

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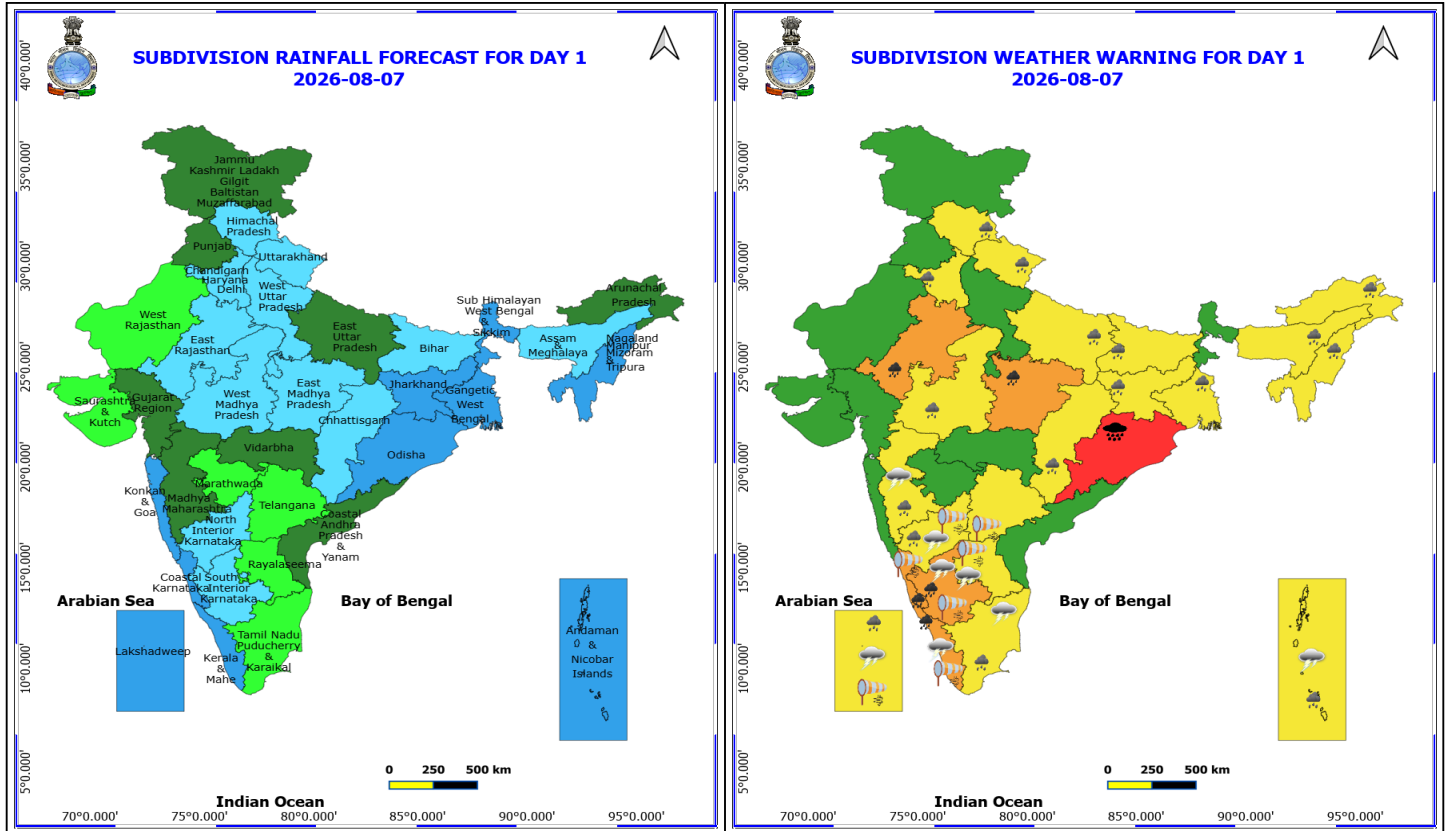


& Sikkim, Bihar, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and North Interior Karnataka. **near normal(-1.5°C to 1.5°C)** at many places over Jharkhand, Jammu-Kashmir, Ladakh-Gilgit-Baltistan-Muzaffarabad, Rayalaseema and Lakshadweep; at most places over West Rajasthan and South Interior Karnataka; at few places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Gangetic West Bengal, Uttarakhand, Punjab and Kerala & Mahe; at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh. **The highest maximum temperature** of 39.0°C was reported at RENTACHINTALA (ANDHRA PRADESH).



Meteorological Analysis (Based on 0530 hours IST)

- The **Monsoon trough** at mean sea level now passes through Ganganagar, Gwalior, Sidhi, Jamshedpur, Digha and thence southeastwards Eastcentral Bay of Bengal.
- The upper **air cyclonic circulation** over south Gangetic West Bengal & adjoining Bangladesh persists and now extends upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwards with height. Under its influence a low pressure area is likely to form over the coastal areas of Gangetic West Bengal & adjoining northwest Bay of Bengal during next 24 hours.
- An **upper air cyclonic circulation** lies over Jharkhand & neighbourhood and extends 1.5 km above mean sea level.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over southwest Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood persists and now extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- The **Western Disturbance** as a trough in middle & upper tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level roughly along Long. 73°E to the north of Lat. 29°N persists.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over southeast Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood persists and now seen between 4.5 & 5.8 km above mean sea level.
- The **upper air cyclonic circulation** over Southeast Bay of Bengal between 4.5 & 5.8 km above mean sea level persists.

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Fig. 1: Maximum Temperatures Dated 2026-08-06

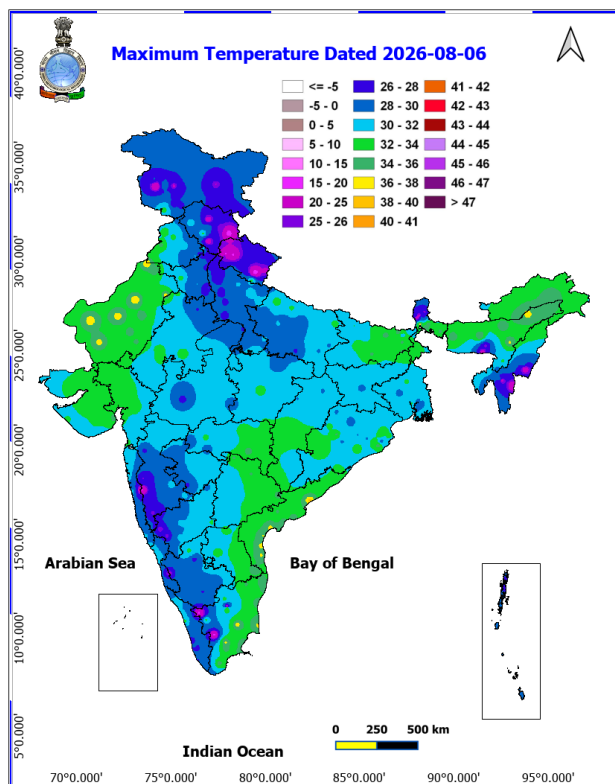


Fig. 2: Departure of Maximum Temp. Dated 2026-08-06

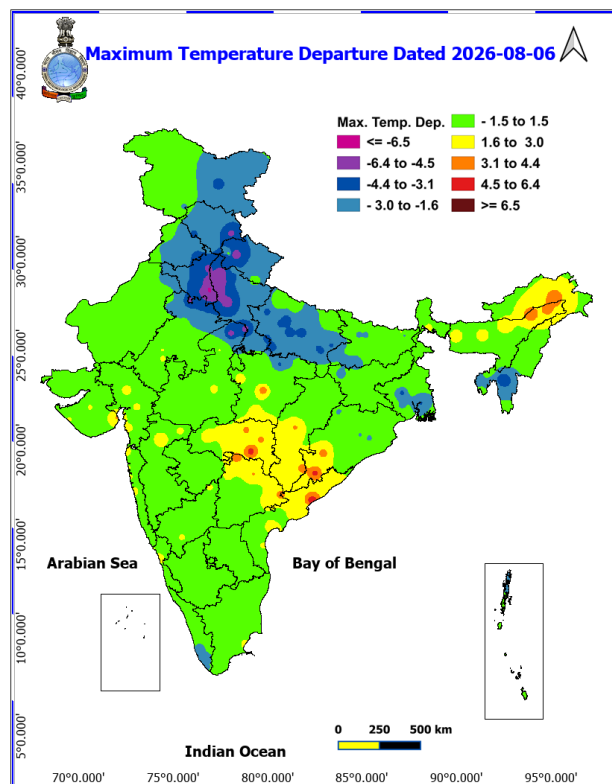


Fig. 3: Minimum Temperatures Dated 2026-08-06

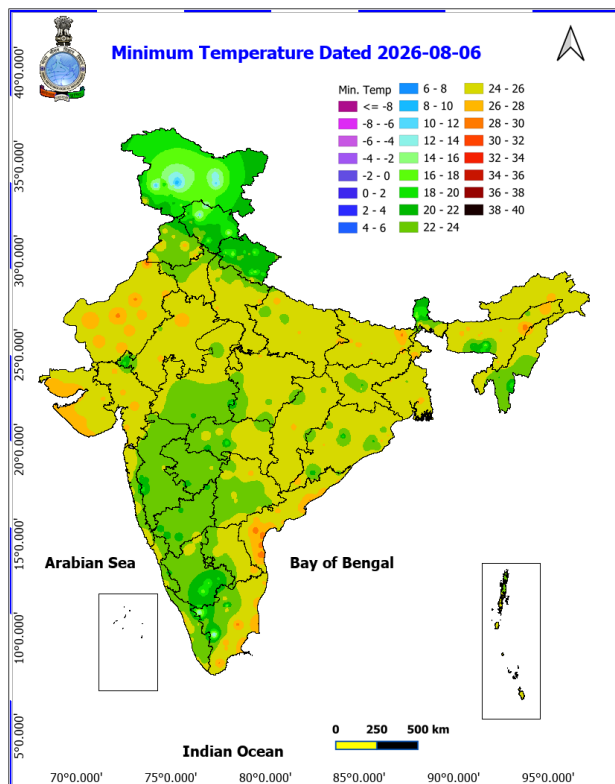
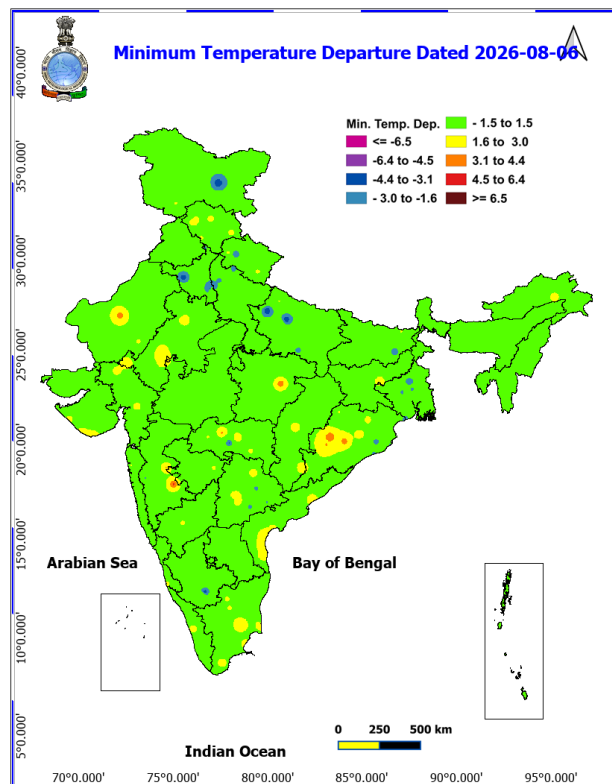
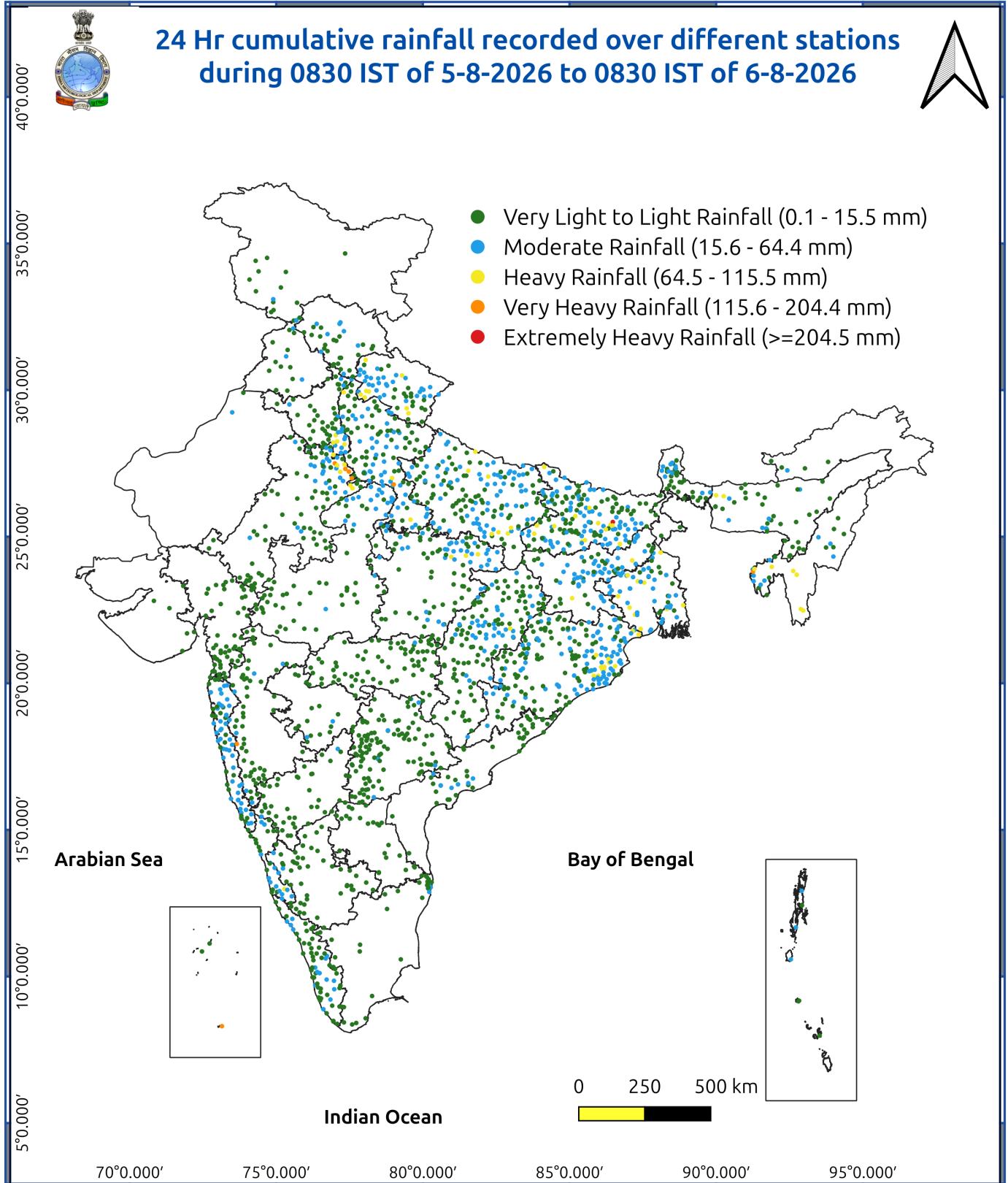


Fig. 4: Departure of Minimum Temp. Dated 2026-08-06





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Impact and Actions

Impact Expected and Action Suggested due to very heavy rainfall:

- **Heavy to Very Heavy Rainfall with isolated Extremely Heavy Rainfall very likely at isolated places over Odisha.**
- **Isolated very heavy rainfall** also likely over East Madhya Pradesh, Coastal Karnataka, Kerala & Mahe and South Interior Karnataka 7th; East Rajasthan during 7th-9th; Odisha on 8th August.

Impact expected:

- Breaking of tree branches, uprooting of small trees like banana, papaya, drum sticks. Strong wind and rain may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds and rain.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls, huts and roads due to heavy rain.
- Loose objects may fly.
- Small ships, trawlers and boats may be affected.
- Road and rail traffic may be affected due to heavy rain and squally winds.
- There could be localised landslides, mudslides, landslips, water logging, inundation and flooding over low lying areas.
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Helicopter services may get affected.

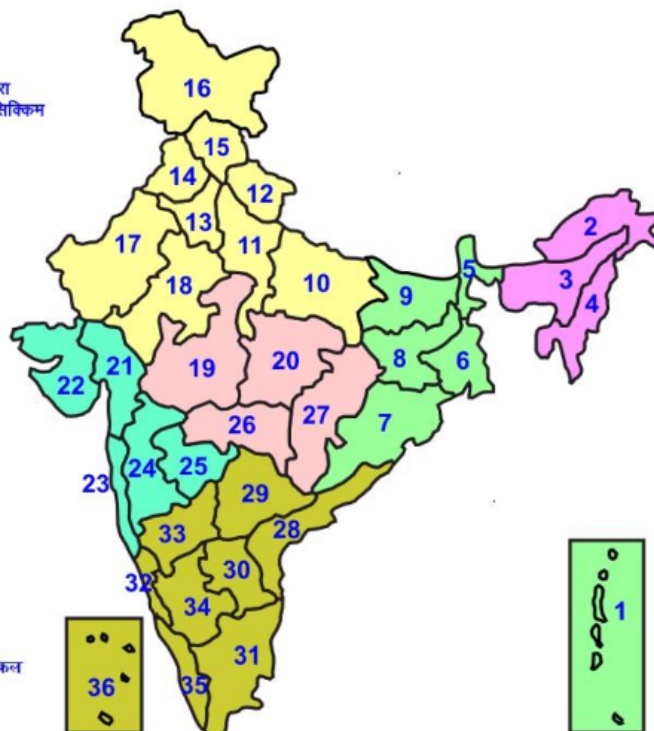
Action suggested:

- People are advised to keep a watch on the weather for worsening conditions and be ready to move to safer places accordingly.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees, as there could be lightning.
- In case of expected lightning, unplug electrical/ electronic appliances, immediately, get out of water bodies and keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.
- Tourism and recreational activities to be regulated.
- Onshore and offshore activities to be judiciously regulated.
- Helicopter services to be regulated.
